
CONCEPT


A seamless pattern is an image or texture that can be duplicated and placed side-by-side, without distinct borders or separations. These patterns enable a single image to be endlessly repeated to create unique backgrounds using geometric shapes or iconography. This means a tile should be constructed in such a way that elements on its right border perfectly match ones on its left border, and top and bottom borders match as well.


















PRELIMINARY SKETCHES



REFINED SKETCH



COMPUTER RENDERS

My refined sketch was the main reference to my seamless pattern. I scanned it and increased the contrast and brightness to make the lines darker and the background clean and white. Then I vectorized my dolls and added details and colors.



COLOR SELECTION

The Russian dolls are full of joyful colors and the colors usually draw children's attention. I decided to choose a variety of colors for this theme. Finally I settled on magenta, green, yellow and light blue.



STYLIZATION

I felt this pattern needed some details that would give life to these dolls. I decided to add decorations to the clothes, give a pink color to the dolls' cheeks. I also applied background for the pattern, which can be viewed on the next page.
